Malignant: Gastric tumour (for monitoring and detection of residual tumour).  
Certain breast, colorectal, biliary tract, lung and ovarian tumors.

Benign: COPD, liver disease, pancreatitis and benign breast and ovarian disease.

Medication: Proton pump inhibitors, NSAIDs and corticosteroids.

Please note: CA72-4 is performed on the Roche (immunoassay) and is linear and accurate up to 250 U/mL. Dilutions cannot be performed above this cut-off.
